The Federal Government estimates that nearly forty-seven percent of the land in California is federal property.

RETROCESSION

Retrocession means giving something back to its original owner.

The New Calexit Plan establishes an autonomous Native American nation-state in North America by retroceding almost all federal property in California to the Native Americans which originally inhabited those lands.

WHAT PARTS OF CALIFORNIA ARE FEDERAL PROPERTY?

FORESTS

Many of California's forests will be returned to Native Americans. These include forests from Sequoia, Inyo, and Sierra, to Klamath, Six Rivers, and Shasta-Trinity.

MOUNTAINS

The Federal Government manages most of California's Sierra Nevadas, as well as the Cascade Range in Northern California. These mountains will be retroceded.

DESERTS

The Federal Government manages the land and resources of the High Desert region. Places like Death Valley and the Mojave Desert will be retroceded.

WHICH FEDERAL AGENCIES MANAGE THOSE LANDS?



Virtually all of the territory we will return to Native Americans is currently managed by the National Park Service (NPS), the United States Forest Service (USFS), or the Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

FEDERALLY-OWNED PROPERTIES IN CALIFORNIA

Nearly 47% of the land in California is federal land.

Federal land in California extends along California's border with the United States. It encompasses the resource-rich forests, mountains, and desert areas. The New Calexit Plan returns that land back to Native Americans. This by default, not by design, establishes a "buffer zone" between the United States and California.

THE NEW CALEXIT PLAN



CALIFORNIA

BEHOLD THE FIRST NATIVE AMERICAN NATION-STATE

Autonomous.
Internationally-recognized.

An independent California will not only retrocede these lands back to the Native Americans, but as a member state of the United Nations, California will seek recognition of this nation-state as an observer state, allowing the Native Americans to participate on the world stage in the work of the United Nations General Assembly.

HOW WILL THE NATIVE AMERICAN NATION-STATE SUPPORT ITSELF?

RESOURCES

Native Americans will finally have control of the natural resources that exist on and under the lands of this Native American nation-state.

TOURISM

Many world-famous tourist destinations and vacation spots such as Lake Tahoe will bring tourists and revenue to this Native American nation-state.

COMMERCE

International trade between California and the U.S. will keep people, goods, and revenue flowing through this Native American nation-state.

YES!

California will retain access to water and ownership of existing infrastructure we built on the territory of this Native American nation-state.

NATIVE GOVERNMENT

"It's their land."

All people living within the lands of this Native American nation-state will be required to adhere to Native laws, not Californian, or American laws. But we will sign a treaty establishing this nation-state that guarantees continued access to water, and protects our ownership of existing infrastructure California taxpayers built on those lands over the years. And yes, there will be a free passage agreement to allow for free and unfettered travel for Californian citizens to the U.S. through this Native American nation-state.

THE PLAN OF ACTION

STEP 1

Qualify an independence referendum for the 2020 ballot by circulating a petition to collect enough signatures.

STEP 2

Tell everyone to vote YES on our ballot measure on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 - the next U.S. Presidential Election.

STEP 3

Tell everyone to vote YES on Independence on May 4, 2021 in a special independence referendum vote.

STEP 4

The California Legislature passes a resolution in support of California secession from the United States.

STEP 5

California requests 25 (or more) state legislatures to pass the same resolution in support of California secession.

STEP 6

California declares independence from the United States having obtained "the consent of the states".
